Attention: Intersen Phase Parents and Learners

It gives us immense pleasure to welcome you back after an absence of almost five months in most instances.

As a school we had to adopt a risk adjusted approach which is aligned to the very necessary COVID-19 protocols. This is in-keeping with the prescribed standard operating procedures.

Please take note of the following:

1. **Date of re-admissions:**

24 August 2020 for **ALL** learners (Grade 5's included).

2. **School Times:**

07h00 - 14h00 daily (including Mondays). Please make necessary transport arrangement for your child as there will be **NO** teachers on duty after 14h00.

3. The aftercare facility will also re- open on 24 August 2020. Please make use of the facility (for a fee of R35 day) if you unable to collect your child on time. No food will be provided as per COVID-19 protocol. Please pack extra sandwiches if you are to be late.

4. Alternating Attendance of Learners

The "new normal" dictates that we social distance our learners. That being the case, each class has been divided into an A & B sub-class and their attendance will be on alternating days in a 2 week cycle. Please check which group your child is in and follow the dates (see attached) for your child's presence at school.

The staff of the school would appreciate it, if you could familiarize your child with the details for arriving at school on the 24th of August 2020.

The staff also request that you start training them on how to use a mask and to allow them to keep it on for long periods of time. So please allow them to keep them on at home.

We also request that the learners bring to school, paper towels to dry their hands after hand washing as cloth towels are very unhygienic.



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5. Parents must ensure that their child travel in a deep cleaned taxi and adhere to the law of the country when travelling in public transport.
6. Every learner coming to school on the 24th of August must arrive at school wearing his/her own mask as this is a mandatory requirement of the country.
7. There will only be one entrance onto the school property for Gr 4-7 learners and that is the gate on Second Avenue leading into the school hall. Gr 1-3 learners have to enter through the big black gate on Third Avenue. No exceptions will be made.
8. The pavement will be marked with the correct social distancing measures and when your child arrives at school they have to stand on these lines and wait until they are screened.
9. If they pass the screening tests they will enter and wait in the quad. They are not allowed to play on the field. At this point a register will be taken and the children will be given the PPE's from the department and shown how to use them. When they get home these masks will need to be washed as the children will need to wear them every day.
10. A screening "passport" will be issued to your child on their first day back; this passport contains health questionnaires that need to be completed on a daily basis. This "passport" needs to be presented to the staff at the gate in order to be allowed access to the school property. Please take note of the following:
 - The questionnaire has to be completed every morning at home.
 - Please complete the questionnaire with your child so that you can be aware of any symptoms displayed.
 - All questions should be answered truthfully so that we do not compromise the health and safety of others.
 - If you find that your child displays any of the symptoms mentioned in the questionnaire, do NOT send him/her to school. We cannot allow the child to enter the school and he/she will have to be sent home.
 - Any child forgetting to carry their passport will be in breach of the prescribed operating procedure and will NOT be allowed into the classroom.
 - Temperatures will still be taken before learners enter the school.



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In the case of a lost passport:

- Please send a letter with your child to school to ensure us that the learner is healthy.
 - Contact the office to purchase a new passport.
 - The amount thereof is R50
11. If your child fails the screening test your child will be placed in the foyer of the hall where you and the department of Health will be contacted for further testing. If your child wakes up in the morning and shows any signs of illness, please keep them at home. If you bring your child to school, wait with your child until he/she has been screened. The private Transport drivers that bring your child to school will have to follow the same protocol as a parent in this instance. If the child fails the screening they will be responsible for taking them back home.
 12. During break each class will be given an area in the school where they will sit and eat with a teacher on duty. Feeding Scheme children will be fed in an allocated feeding area where social distancing can take place.
 13. Once they have finished eating, they will be taken to the toilets where social distancing measures will be put in place and controlled. The Department is only supplying soap, so if you would like your child to hand sanitize, you will need to purchase it.
 14. No Parents/Visitor will be allowed onto the school property. You can phone the school and leave a message with a contactable email address and the teacher/management will get back to you.
 15. All Children are to bring their own water bottles to school as they will not be allowed to drink water straight from a tap.
 16. There will be no sports, cultural or parent meetings during this time.
 17. Please ensure that your child arrives at school on the 24TH August with the necessary stationary, their exercise books as well as textbooks. Due to the fact that so much learning time has been lost, your child needs to know that they must take learning seriously and put every effort into their work. All Homework must be completed by the child.
 18. No borrowing/lending of textbooks, stationery or any other items will be allowed.
 19. The following school rules and Covid-19 protocols must be adhered to by your child or strict disciplinary action will be taken immediately
